<u>Authors Guidelines for the 6th International National Ornamental Plants Congress (Jun 2024).</u>

The articles could be submitted as abstract or full text manuscripts.

Please, submit your paper using Microsoft Word, following the formatting specified below:

Abstracts should include:

- **1- Title** of the paper (typeface: Times New Roman,14 pt, bold, centered) should not be span in more than two rows
- **2- Author name(s)** should be followed by the title by one blank line, written with (typeface: Times New Roman, 12 pt, centered) first name and then family name written in full; authors should be separated by commas. Authors with different affiliations are noted with superscripts (1, 2, etc.) after their names. The corresponding author is noted with an asterisk * after the superscript. The name of the author presenting is underlined.
- **3- Author(s') affiliations** (typeface: Times New Roman, 10 pt, centered) should be written as fallow; institution, department, address, city, postcode, country. The corresponding Author's email is needed.
- **4- Abstract text** (typeface: Times New Roman, 12 pt, text-align: justify) Should be followed by the author name(s) by one blank line and titled with the word "Abstract" (typeface: Times New Roman,12 pt). The abstract should mention the objective, the materials and methods, and the main results presentation including 250 words.
- **5- Keywords** (typeface: Times New Roman, 11 pt) should be followed by the abstract by one blank line, max. 5 words and arranged in alphabetical order.

Full text manuscripts should include:

- The main text of the full paper should follow the keywords by one blank line. Standard size of paper (A4 format) with typeface Times New Roman, 12 pt, single-spaced lines, 2.5 cm margins on each edge of the page is required. Scientific papers and review articles shall not be longer than 4 standard pages, without any page numbers, Header, and footer. The main text should be prepared single-column. Footnotes should be written with Times New Roman, 9 pt. If references are made in the text listed in Literature Cited, refer to them by number(s) in brackets. Manuscripts in a MS Word format (*.doc), should be submitted through e-mail isop.iran@gmail.com
- **Sub-titles** (typeface: Times New Roman, 12 pt, bold) should be written after a blank line in the following part.
- **Introduction**: The introduction should outline the necessary background information, why the research was conducted, the goal of author, and a brief review of previous publications consisting of refereed periodicals, journals, and books for the work presented should be cited.

- Materials and Methods: In the Materials and Methods section, the experimental procedures and statistical method should be described in sufficient detail. Commonly known methods or analyses may be briefly explained by citing relevant references.
- **Results and Discussion:** The Results and Discussion section should contain the brief results of research and explain the conclusions with tables and figures as needed and a discussion of any inconsistency of already published reports.
- **References:** The surnames and initials of all authors should be followed by the year of publication cited, the original title of the paper, the name of the periodical, the relevant volume and page number. In the case of a book or proceedings the title should be followed by the name of the publisher and the place of publication. Names of authors should be separated by commas, not by & or and. Examples of references in the list:

Yin, X., and van Laar, H. H., (2005). Crop Systems Dynamics: An ecophysiological model for genotype-by environment interactions. Wageningen Academic Publishers, Wageningen, the Netherlands, p. 168.

- Tables and figures: Tables and figures should be clear and ready for publish. These should be numbered and embedded in the text at appropriate locations, not at the end of the manuscript, in a consecutive numerical order. There should be a blank line before and after them. Figure captions or table titles should be (written at bottom and the top respectively; with Times New Roman, 9 pt for English) brief but self-explanatory so that they are understandable without reference to the text.
- **Equations** should be embedded by Equation Editor and align left, while the relevant numbers in the same line are align right.

Terms and Conditions

- All author(s) approve submitting their work for presentation.
- The author(s) transfer(s) all copyright ownership of the named abstract to the 6th International and National Ornamental Plants Congress.
- At least one author should be available to present the abstract if their abstract is accepted at the congress. The authors will immediately notify the congress secretariat if they are unable to attend or if the presenting author is changed. The organizers reserve the right to remove a presentation from the program in such cases
